Answer

MINISTER OF LAW & JUSTICE (SHRI SALMAN KHURSHID)

- (a) & (b): Judiciary is independent in India and enjoys wide powers of judicial review. However, the three organs of State have, by and large, functioned within their respective domains maintaining the doctrine of checks and balances.
