- (a) & (b) Yes Madam. Studies on the potential of seaweed farming in the country have been conducted by the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI). The studies have estimated that the Country has the potential to produce about 1 million tonnes dry seaweed.
- (c), (d) & (e) The Government through the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) has introduced a scheme to provide financial assistance for seaweed cultivation.
