(a) to (b) In accordance with the comprehensive policy on alternative modes of delivery of national highways as already approved by the Government, construction and expansion of projects under NHDP Phase III and onwards is undertaken on Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis in Build, Operate and Transfer (BOT) Toll mode, failing which on BOT (Annuity) mode; and failing which on `Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC)` mode.
