- (a) whether the Government has prepared perspective plans for modernization of the three Services of the armed forces during the Twelfth Five Year Plan:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the percentage of defence expenditure spent on modernization of the three forces and procurement of defence equipment during the Eleventh Five Year Plan, Service-wise;
- (d) whether the allocated funds have been optimally utilised;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the corrective measures proposed so as to equip the forces including the Air Force with state-of-the-art equipment?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY)

- (a) & (b): Madam, modernization of the Armed Forces is a continuous process based on threat perception, operational challenges, technological changes and available resources. The process is based on a 15 year Long Term Integrated Perspective Plan (LTIPP), five year Services Capital Acquisition Plan (SCAP) and Annual Acquisition Plan (AAP). The Twelfth Five Year Plan 2012-17 for the Armed Forces has been prepared and is awaiting consideration by the Defence Acquisition Council (DAC).
- (c) Expenditure on modernization of Armed Forces through capital acquisition as percentage of total defence expenditure during the years 2007-08 to 2011-12 was:

(d) to (f): Funds have been optimally utilized to equip the Armed Forces including the Air Force with state-of-the art equipment. The budget estimates (BE), revised estimates (RE) and the actual expenditure on Capital acquisition for modernization of Armed Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force and Joint Staff) was as under:
