Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has granted approval/sanction for the Hyderabad Metro Rail Project;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the present status of the project; and
- (d) the time by which this project is likely to be completed?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a): Yes, Madam.

(b): Government of Andhra Pradesh has undertaken the Hyderabad Metro Rail Project in three traffic corridors of the city spanning over 71 km :-

(1) Miyapur-LB Nagar (28.87 km -27 stations); (2) JBS-Falaknuma (14.78km - 16 stations); & (3) Nagole-Shilparamam (27.51 km – 23 stations). The Project is being executed in PPP mode on design, build, finance, operate and transfer (DBFOT) basis. Financial Closure for the Project was achieved in March 2011. Of the total cost of Rs. 14,132 crore, Rs. 1,458 crore (10%) will be funded by Government of India as central financial assistance under the Viability Gap Funding (VGF) scheme.

(c) & (d): Preparatory works have been completed and the ground works have been commenced. The Project is scheduled to be completed in 2016.
