INTEGRATED SEWERAGE SYSTEM UNDER JNNURM

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of cities in Odisha that are covered under integrated sewerage system under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission(JNNURM);
- (b) whether the Government has approved allocation of funds for this purpose;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, city/town-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has plans to cover more cities in Odisha under the integrated sewerage system under the JNNURM; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a)to (c): Under Urban Infrastructure & Governance (UIG) Sub-Mission of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission(JNNURM) an Integrated Sewerage project has been approved for the Mission city of Bhubaneswar with approved cost of Rs.49891.35 lakhs and Additional Central Assistance (ACA) commitment of Rs.39913.08 lakhs. Under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) of JNNURM a Sewerage project has been approved for the city of Sambalpur with approved cost of Rs.593.23 lakhs and Additional Central Assistance (ACA) commitment of Rs.483.48 lakhs.

(d) & (e): The Mission has completed its normal tenure on 31st March, 2012. The Government has extended the period for further 2 years till March 31, 2014 only for completion of projects sanctioned upto 31st March, 2012 and ongoing reforms. This does not envisages sanction of any fresh project.
