(a) & (b) During the visit of Prime Minister to the Republic of Korea from 24 - 27 March 2012, an Agreement on Simplification of Visa Procedures was signed to encourage greater contacts, travel and engagement between India and the Republic of Korea. A Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation between Korea National Diplomatic Academy (KNDA) and Foreign Service Institute (FSI) to exchange faculty, trainees, and best practices was also concluded.
