- (a) whether Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises in the country provide more employment opportunities in comparison to heavy industries even with small investment:
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (c) the total number of Micro, Small and Medium enterprises functioning in the country, separately, State-wise?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI VIRBHADRA SINGH)

- (a)&(b): As per the Final Report of the Fourth Census of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) 2006-07:Registred Sector, for which the data was collected in 2009 & report published in 2011, the employment intensity (measured in terms of employment per unit of fixed assets) for MSME sector was 0.20. This was higher than the employment intensity of the factories sector i.e.0.15, as per the Annual Survey of Industries, 2006-2007.
- (c): As per the Final Report of the Fourth Census of MSMEs: 2006-07, the total number of registered MSMEs functioning in the country stands at 15.64 lakh. As per the Quick Result of the Fourth Census of MSMEs: 2006-07, the total number of unregistered MSMEs in the country stands at 245.48 lakh. The state-wise distribution of Registered and Unregistered Enterprises are given in Annexure 1.
