- (a) whether the Government has any schemes to train tribals in the art of skill development and similar other jobs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the employment opportunities created therefrom; and
- (c) the number of tribal families benefitted from these schemes during the last three years and the current years?

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tribal Affairs implements a Central Sector Scheme called 'Vocational Training in Tribal Areas' under which grant-in-aid is provided to the State Governments/UT Administrations and Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) for running Vocational Training Centres (VTCs). The main aim of this scheme is to upgrade the skills of tribal youth in various traditional/modern vocations depending upon their educational qualifications, present economic trends and market potential. The grant-in-aid is provided for imparting training to Scheduled Tribes in VTCs to enable them to get employment/self-employment. The details of number of trainees (State-wise) for which grant-in-aid has been released during the last three years and current year is at Annexure.
