- (a) & (b): There is no categorization of villages as tribal village by the Ministry.
- (c) to (e): Does not arise in view of reply to Part (a) & (b) above. However, the Ministry provides grants out of funds for Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub Plan for the Development of Forest Villages. Funds are provided for activities related to livelihood and infrastructure works meant for providing basic services of facilities.
