(d) the steps taken by the Government to check the increase in the prices of iron ore in the country?

(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. Prices of iron ore in the country has shown an increase in the last three years. The details, indicating percentage of increase in the prices of iron ore during each of the last three years is given in Annexure. The mining sector, including mining and trade in iron ore, has been liberalized since the year 1993 and prices of iron ore is driven by global market demand. The Government does not administer the prices of iron ore in the country.
