- (a) whether at least 500 Km of National Highways out of 7300 Km would be build with 100 percent Government funding;

- (c) whether 1500 Km roads would be awarded by the State and Central Governments; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) The Ministry has set a target for award of 8800 km of National Highways (NHs) projects including 1306 km to be awarded by the Ministry through State Agencies during 2012-13. The detailed tentative work plan for award of the projects during 2012-13 is annexed. The projects will be awarded on Build, Operate & Transfer (BOT) basis under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode depending on the viability of project.
