Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal for six-laning of Belgaum- Kolhapur section of NH-4;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be approved/cleared by the Government?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (c) No, Madam. However, the stretch from Kolhapur to Kagal on NH-4, having a length of about 20 km, is included under NHDP-Phase-V for six laning and Request for Qualification (RFQ) is under process by National Highways Authority of India (NHA). It is too early to give the time schedule for its approval by the Government.
