However, the modifications are made in the norms specified for technical experience for highways projects on a case-to-case basis, including the projects in Scheduled areas, etc., based on opinions of the concerned executive agency / State Government depending upon the specific difficulties / problems of the area affecting bid responses, etc. Apart from this, the review of the norms for Technical Experience for Highways Projects are also made from time to time and modifications are carried out depending upon experiences gained, feedbacks received from various executive agencies including State Governments, other stakeholders, such as contractors, etc., and experts.
