(a): Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) is imparting training in the country including Rajasthan through 22 departmental as well as 18 non-departmental training centres.

(b) & (c): Improvement and upgradation of training centres is a continuous process, through the grants received by KVIC for human resource development and marketing.

(d) to (e) : KVIC has reported that it received one proposal during 2011-12 from Manipur State for establishment of a new trainingcum-production centre for pottery on cost sharing basis between State Government and KVIC. The matter has not been referred to the Ministry by KVIC.
