- (a) the number of the Non-Government Organisations (NGOs) against whom action has been taken by CAPART during the last three years and the number of NGOs out of them who challanged the said action in court;
- (b) the time since when these cases are subjudice;
- (c) whether any review has been made on subjudice cases;
- (d) if so, the outcome of such reviews; and
- (e) if not, the reaction of the Government thereto and corrective steps taken in this regard?
