(a), (b) and (c) It is proposed to merge the two existing schemes, the Kishori Shakti Yojana and the Nutrition Programme for Adolescent Girls presently under implementation by the Ministry, and formulate a comprehensive scheme for adolescent girls in the age group of 11 to 18 years in the country. The details of the Scheme are being worked out.
