- (a) whether the Government proposes to privatise or handover the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme to corporate/Non- Governmental Organisations;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has consulted the public representatives and concerned people in this connection; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (d): The Scheme of ICDS is a Centrally Sponsored Programme implemented through the State Governments/UT Administrations. The Scheme, since inception, envisaged involvement of Voluntary Organisations, Central Social Welfare Board, local bodies, Panchayati Raj Institutions; (where these are functioning efficiently) etc. to be actively involved in this Programme for implementation, soliciting community support etc. There is no proposal to privatize the ICDS.
