- (c) if so, the number of such NGOs to whom financial assistance has been provided by CSWB during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

- (a): Central Social Welfare Board (CSWB) implements five schemes, namely Short Stay Home, Family Counselling Centre, Condensed Courses of Education for women, Awareness Generation Projects, Rajiv Gandhi National Creche Scheme for the Children of Working Mothers. Details of the schemes are at Annexure-I.
- (b): Yes Madam, CSWB provides financial assistance to NGOs for implementation of its programmes.
- (c): The number of NGOs to whom financial assistance has been provided by CSWB during each of last three years and the current year, state-wise is at Annexure-II.
