- (a) whether the Government has introduced a concession scheme for urea units based on feedstock used and the vintage of plants as recommended by the Expenditure Reforms Commission;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of such units dismantled in the country?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Keeping in view the recommendations of Expenditure Reforms Commission in its report on rationalizing fertilizer subsidy, Government introduced the Group Based Scheme i.e. New Pricing Scheme for urea units to replace the Retention Price Scheme(RPS). Six groups based on vintage and feestock were formed. NPS is being implemented in stages. Stage-I was of one year duration from 1.4.2003 to 31.3.2004. Stage-II was of two and a half years duration, from 1.4.2004 to 30.9.2006. The concession rates payable to the urea units were determined on the basis of group averaging of retention prices of urea units as on 31.3.2003.
- (c) No urea unit has been dismantled so far.
