- (a) whether the overnment is aware of the increasing incidents of sexual abuse of children reputed from various parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the dails thereof along with the number of such incidents reported during each of th`iast three years; and;
- (c) the steps tken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA TIRATH)

- (a) As inormed by National Crime Records Bureau a total of 4026, 4721 and 5045 cases of raj of children (upto 18 years of age) were reported in the country during 2005, 200 and 2007, respectively, thereby showing an increasing trend in the incidence such cases.
- (b) State/UT wise details of cases registered under rape of children during 2005,2006 an 2007 are enclosed at Annexure.
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard are as under:-
- (i) Implementation of Indian Penal Code, 1860;
- (ii) Implementation of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act 1956;
- (iii) Implementation of Juvenile Justice(Oare and Protection of Children) Act 2000 as amended in 2006;
- (iv) Implementation of Integrated Child Protection Scheme for protection of children in need of care and protection which includes child victims of sexual abuse.
- (v) Setting up of National Commissio n for Protection of Child Rights;
- (vi) Implementation of Ujjawala Scheme for Prevention of Trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation and Re-1 ntegration of Victims of Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation.
