(a) As per information available with Ministry of Steel, Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) in the public sector and Tata Steel, Jindal Steel & Power Limited, Lloyd Metals & Engineers Limited, Usha Martin Limited, Jindal Saw Limited, Jayaswal Neco Industries Limited, Ispat Industries Limited, in the private sector are the major iron and steel companies, which have been allocated captive iron ore mines by the concerned State Governments.

(b)&(c): There is no provision in the existing Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and rules there under regarding auction for grant of permission with regard to extraction of iron ore.
