- (a) the number of mothers and children registered under the web enabled mother and child tracking system;
- (b) whether the system generates weekly work plan for the Auxiliary Nurse Midwives through SMS; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a): 2, 07, 55,732 pregnant women and 1, 47, 69,451 children have been registered under Mother & Child Tracking System (MCTS) as on 01/05/2012.

(b) & (c): Yes. The system generates daily, weekly and monthly work plan for the Auxiliary Nurse Midwives and communicates it through SMS. SMS alerts are also sent to the beneficiaries. All the States/ UTs have started using the SMS feature of the Mother & Child Tracking System (MCTS) portal.
