Answer

MINISTER OF SHIPPING (SHRI G.K. VASAN)

- (a) & (b): There is no proposal to amend the Cabotage law. However this Ministry has received representations from various groups in favour of and against the Cabotage restrictions.
- (c) & (d): Government is planning to start new ports in the country and has requested coastal States in the country to submit comprehensive proposals in this regard. So far, proposals have been received from the State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Gujarat and Kerala.
