(a): The Tipaimukh Hydro Electric Project (1500 MW), Manipur is proposed to be taken up through a Joint Venture (JV) between NHPC, SJVNL and Government of Manipur. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and Promoters Agreement have been signed on 28.04.2010 & 22.10.2011 respectively. Finalization of Memorandum of Association (MoA) & Article of Association (AoA) by JV Partners is in progress.

The concurrence to the Detailed Project Report (DPR) and environment clearance have already been accorded in favour of NEEPCO, which would be transferred in favour of the Joint Venture. The forest clearance is also under process.
