- (d) whether the Government has nominated the said site for declaration as UNESCO World Heritage Site; and

The conservation and maintenance work of the monuments is a continuous process and it is attended at this site also on regular basis depending upon the need of repairs and availability of resources.

(d)&(e) Vikramshila Mahavihara is one of the prominent Silk Road Sites in India and it is currently on UNESCO's Tentative List.
