- (a) the status of widening, four laning and six laning of road projects under the National Highways Development Project (NHDP) undertaken during the current Five Year Plan particularly for the State of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) whether the Government has accorded the approval to the proposed projects of widening of National Highway NH-24 and NH-58;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has also chalked out any time-bound programme to complete the said project; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Details of projects awarded during the 11th five year plan (2007-2012) in the State of Uttar Pradesh are enclosed as Annex-I
- (b) to (e) Widening and improvement of NH-24 and NH-58 have been included under Delhi-Meerut Expressway (DME) project under NHDP Phase-VI. On the basis of Final Feasibility Report, the proposed widening is under finalization as per details enclosed as Annex-II. It is too early to indicate any time frame for its completion at this stage as it is not yet approved.
