- (a) and (b) The collective premium quote on 32 projects awarded by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) during the year 2011-12, amounts to Rs.2978.68 crore. The actual flow on account of premium quotes is likely to come to NHAI only in subsequent years after achieving the Commercial Operation Dates (COD) in respective projects except for 6 laning projects under Phase-V projects of the National Highways Development Projects (NHDP). A list of all such projects awarded on premium during the year 2011-12 is placed at Annexure.
