- (b) the policy of the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) As per the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) 12182 the feasible service time for reservoir relevant to irrigation projects is not less than 100 years and for hydro projects the same shall not be less than 70 years. This limitation is not applicable to structural safety of dam, which depends on quality of design, construction and maintenance. The structural safety of dam is the responsibility of dam owners and as such no information has been furnished by any of the dam owners regarding any dam that has outlived its life. As such no specific policies are available to decide the life of dam structure.
