**Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has convened any meeting of State Chief Ministers to discuss the progress of water projects of the States in the Eleventh Five Year Plan;
- (b) if so, the details discussed and decisions arrived at so far;
- (c) the implementation status thereof, State-wise and project-wise;
- (d) the pending demands from each State especially from Andhra Pradesh during the Eleventh Five Year Plan; and
- (e) the future action plan for the Twelfth Five Year Plan for Andhra Pradesh as compared to other States?

- (a) to (c) No, Madam. However, in the 55th meeting of National Development Council (NDC) held in July 2010 and convened by Planning Commission, the Mid Term Appraisal of the Eleventh Five Year Plan was approved by the NDC.
- (d) & (e) The state-wise details of number of projects reported spillover to XII Plan along with the financial targets including those of Andhra Pradesh is given at Annexure- I. The Planning Commission convened the 56th NDC meeting on 22.10.2011 to consider the Approach Paper of the XII Five Year Plan.
