(a) & (b) Large parts of India have already become water stressed. Rapid growth in demand for water due to population growth, urbanization and changing lifestyle pose serious challenges to water security.

(c) & (d) There is presently no proposal to formulate a separate National Drinking Water policy since policy issues regarding drinking water are already covered in National Water Policy.
