- (b) if so, the details of the feedback received by the Union Government;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the State Governments have not framed any specific pro cedure for scrutinizing and executing recommendations under MPLADS;
- (d) if so, whether the Union Government has given any directions to the State Gover nments as regards the procedure to be followed with respect to the MPLADS projects as distinguished from State Projects; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The Ministry reviews and monitors implementation of the scheme twice in a year with Nodal Secretaries of the State/UT Governments, apart from regular reviews of implementation of the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) in the States.
- (b) Despite positive views of the public about MPLAD Scheme, deficiencies in implementa tion of scheme have been found at the district level which include: delay in execution of works, incomplete works and poor use of assets, encroachment, diversion of use, lack of main tenance, idle assets, etc.
- (c) As per MPLADS guidelines, the District Authorities are required to execute works under the scheme, as per the established procedure of the State Government for implementation of such works.
