(a)to (c): Government has not given direction to any specific bank to consider proposal for merger/amalgamation with a particular bank. The initiatives for consolidation emanate from the management of the banks themselves with Government playing a supportive role as the common shareholder. While supporting any merger proposal, Government keeps in view the interests of the stakeholders and employees of merging banks.
