- (c) the present status thereof?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H.MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Government of Andhra Pradesh requested for taking up/ expediting progress on 11 new lines & 2 doubling projects falling fully /partly in Andhra Pradesh. Out of these 13 proposals, 8 proposal have been taken up. Two projects namely, Bhadrachalam-Kovur and Akkanapet-Medak are proposed for sanction in Budget 2012-13. Proposal for Mannuguru-Ramagundam, Pandurangapuram-Sarpaka and Kadri-Puttaparthy has been sent to Planning Commission for 'in principle' approval. No proposal has, however, been received from Government of Andhra Pradesh for inclusion of stations under 'Adarsh Station' Scheme.
