- (a): The supply of sanitary napkins under the scheme for promotion of Menstrual Hygiene among adolescent girls (10-19 years) was started in 2011 providing the girls sanitary napkins at Rs. 1 per piece through ASHAs. The supply is on-going and has not yet been completed. Therefore the report of the number of girls that have been benefitted from this scheme in different States has not yet been compiled.
