Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether wasteland development works have been undertaken under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in the country including Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Union Government had asked the State Governments to give priority to this work; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Para 1B of Schedule-I of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) as amended from to time, lists in the order of their priority the category of works that any Scheme prepared by a State Government under Section 4 (1) of MGNREG Act shall focus upon vide notification dated 4th May, 2012, amendments to Schdule-I & II have been carried out according to which the Gram Panchayats in meetings of Gram Sabha and Ward Sabha are to determine the order of priority of works listed in Schedule-I of the Act.

The details of number of works in different categories completed under MGNREGA during 2009-10 to 2011-12, as reported by States/UTs, are given in Annexure.
