- (b) if so, the details of the projects cleared and those under consideration during the last three years, State-wise including Arunachal Pradesh and project-wise; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to expedite the clearance of the pending projects?

(a) to (c): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

- (a) & (b) A total of 11 road Projects are awaiting Environmental clearance. 560 road projects are awaiting Forest Clearance. Details of projects granted Environment and Forest clearances during the last three years and those under consideration are placed at Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively.
- (c) For facilitating early appraisal of projects various steps have been initiated which include:
- (i) monthly and longer duration of meetings of Expert Appraisal Committee for consideration of projects
- (ii) regular monitoring of the status of the pending projects,
- (iii) Streamlining of the procedure and
- (iv) preparation of manuals & model ToRs for guiding the proponents to prepare EIA report etc.
