(a) & (b) A project titled 'Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project` was signed on 22.07.10 with World Bank for International Bank for Reconstruction and Development loan of US\$ 25.21 million and International Development Association Credit of SDR 25.7 million

(equivalent to US\$ 38.94 million). The project involves States of Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal. The objectives of the proposed project are :

- (i) to build tangible human and technical capacity in selected state pollution control agencies for undertaking environmentally sound remediation of polluted sites; and
- (ii) to support the development of a policy, institutional and methodological framework to establish a National Program for Rehabilitation of Polluted Sites.
