Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently received any proposals from Tamil Nadu for construction of four lane/six lane roads connecting Chengappalli-Walayar (NH-47), Kangeyampalayam-Mettupalayam (NH-67), Dindigul- Coimbatore (NH-209);
- (b) if so, the details of funds released/utilised, project-wise;
- (c) the details of the projects completed as well as delayed projects alongwith the reasons for delay in completion of these projects; and
- (d) the action taken/being taken by the Government to complete these pending projects early?

- (c) & (d) The project of Chengapalli-Walayar section is targeted to be completed by March, 2013. So far 37 km out of 54.86 km is completed in this project. Four Laning of Kangeyapalayam- Mettupalayam section of NH-67 is in the process of bidding and feasibility study for 2/4 laning of Dindigul-Coimbatore-TN/ Karnataka Border section is in progress.
