Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress made so far in the construction of overbridge on National Highway (NH) No. 49 in Khokhasa and Champa Yard level crossing, Janjgir Chama district in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) whether there has been any delay in the construction of said rail overbridge;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which it is likely to be started/completed?

- (a) to (c) The Bilaspur to Urdawal section of National Highway(NH)-49 has been identified under National Highway Development Programme (NHDP) phase-IV for its development on Built Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis. Due to proposed bypass at Janjgir-Champa, the Road Over Bridge (ROB) at Khokhasa and Champa Yard level crossing are excluded from the said programme. However, construction of these ROBs are included in the State budget for the year 2012-13.
- (d) It is too early to indicate any time frame.
