- (a) whether the Government has started work on its proposed Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) connecting Delhi, Ghaziabad and Meerut;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time frame fixed for its completion;
- (c) whether the RRTS would be linked with the existing Delhi Metro project; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

- (a)&(b) No, Madam. Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut is one of the three prioritized corridors identified for Regional Rail Transit System (RRTS). Feasibility Report for this corridor has been prepared.
- (c)&(d) RRTS is planned to be integrated with existing Delhi Metro for appropriate dispersal of passengers.
