(a)&(b) No, Madam. Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut is one of the three prioritized corridors identified for Regional Rail Transit System (RRTS). Feasibility Report for this corridor has been prepared.

(c)&(d) RRTS is planned to be integrated with existing Delhi Metro for appropriate dispersal of passengers.
