Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government is aware that fishermen of the country including Maharashtra are not getting subsidised High Speed Diesel (HSD) for their fishing vessels;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government is considering to remove the Below Poverty Line condition for fishermen;

(d) if so, the time by which a decision is likely to be taken in this regard; and

(e) the other steps taken by the Government to provide subsidised diesel to fishermen?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (DR.CHAHAN DAS MAHANT)

(a) and (b): The Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries under a Centrally Sponsored Scheme provides a rebate on High Speed Diesel (HSD) to the rune of 50% of the sales tax exempted by the States with a ceiling of ? 3 per liter for use of mechanized fishing vessels. This rebate is restricted to

(i) vessels of less than 20 meter length, registered before 10th plan,

(ii) owned by fishermen belonging to Below Poverty Line (BPL) category and

(iii) 500 liters of HSD per boat per active fishing month. The State of Maharashtra has not accessed funds under this scheme during the past three years.

(c) to (e) Restoration of rebate on HSD to all categories has not been supported due to limited availability of funds.
