- (a) whether the Government has received same proposals from various State Governments including Chhattisgarh for the intensive Dairy Development Programme in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the details of projects undertaken under the Intensive Dairy Development Programme in the country during each of the last three years, State-wise;
- (d) the amount sanctioned and released for each of the above projects during the said period, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of targets set and achieved in each of the above projects?

- (a) to (d) Department of Animal Husbandry Dairying & Fisheries, Government of India has received 127 proposals including 4 proposals from the state of Chhattisgarh, under Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP) since inception. Out of 127 proposals, 104 project proposals, including 4 proposals of Chhattisgarh. have been approved by the Department up to 31.03.2012. A Statement indicating state-wise and project-wise details of projects undertaken, since inception including during each of the last three years is given at Annexure I. As regards remaining 23 proposals details are at Annexure II.
- (e) The details of targets set and achieved in each of the above projects is at Annexure III.
