Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that India has emerged as the top country for hiring personnel, particularly in IT, Banking and Manufacturing sectors for 2012;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (c) the manner in which the country proposes to capitalize of this and dominate in providing manpower to other countries?

Answer

(SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY) (a) to (c): Generation of employment is a function of economic growth. Approach paper to the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17) focuses on faster, sustainable and more inclusive growth for creating adequate livelihood opportunities. The approach paper estimates that the manufacturing sector will create around 3 to 4 million jobs over and above the pace of job creation in the recent past. The Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and Employment has been conducting quarterly quick employment survey on Changes in Employment in selected Sectors. As per the report for the 13th quarterly survey conducted during October-December, 2011, additional new employment opportunities have been reported in different industries including IT/BPO sector in India. As per report of the thirteen quarterly survey conducted during October-December, 2011, the employment in IT/BPO sector has shown an increase of 19.80 lakh during the October, 2008 to December, 2011.
