(a) The National Legal Services Authority (NALSA), whose administrative expenses are defrayed out of the Consolidated Fund of India, has allotted funds to the various State; Legal Services Authorities for establishing Mediation Centres in the States.

(b) The State-wise details in respect of these Mediation Centres is given in the Annexure.

(c) The requisite information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

(d) No future policy in this regard is proposed at present.
