## Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to impose additional tax on purchase of new cars in view of the rising cost of diesei;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the number of diesei cars being sold every month in the country presently?

## Answer

## MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI S.S. PALANIMANICKAM)

(a): No, Madam.

(b): Does not arise in view of (a) above.

(c): Tax on purchase of goods is a state subject and hence the Union Government is not empowered to impose it. The rates of excise duty applicable to cars, including diesei cars, have already been enhanced in the Budget for 2012-13.

(d): This data is not being maintained by the Government. According to information obtained from Society of Indian Automobile manufacturers (SIAM), the estimated sale of personalised diesei vehicles, including utility vehicles, in 2010-11 was 9,35,074 which yields a monthly average of 77,923 vehicles.
