(a) The Irrigation Department, Haryana has informed that the quantum of water required for irrigation in the State of Haryana at present is 25.25 million acre feet.

(b) & (c) The Irrigation Department, Haryana has informed that sufficient water is not being supplied to the State of Haryana for irrigation due to less availability of surface water, depleting ground water level and non-receipt of Sutlej Yamuna Link (SYL) water.
