Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Vietnam has expressed their keenness to source teachers from India to teach English as well as to train their teachers in English;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has examined the request of Vietnam;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the manner in which the Government proposes to assist Vietnam in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI E. AHAMED)

(a) to (e): The Vietnam side has expressed its interest to source teachers from India to teach English as well as to train their teachers in English and the matter was discussed during the visit of Vietnamese Deputy Prime Minister to India on 29th March, 2012. The matter has also been discussed during the Joint Working Group Meeting between India and Vietnam held on 7th May, 2012. However, no specific proposal has been received from the Vietnamese side. The Government of India will examine the feasibility of such proposal once received and decide the manner in which such assistance is to be provided to Vietnam.
