Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the States which have spent more than 60 per cent of funds released under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) during each of the last three years;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to allocate additional funds to the States for spending more than 60 per cent of funds released under the programme;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of the States which are to be allocated additional funds under the programme?

Answer

MINISTER OF DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI JAIRAM RAMESH)

- (a): The details of the states which have spent more than 60 percent of funds released under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) during each of the last three years is at Annexure.
- (b) & (c): The allocation of additional funds to the states who have spent more than 60 percent of the available funds i.e. opening balance and releases under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) is done on the request from the States and is based on the availability of savings, the capacity of the State to absorb additional funds and fulfil all conditions required of them for release.
- (d): The allocation of additional funds to the States under the Programme are considered at the end of the financial year.
